Where are the 2 Palestinian territories


They are the Gaza Strip and the West Bank













WHERE? Where is the main Jewish religious site in Jerusalem?

WHY? Why is the Temple Mount so important?

It's three times a holy site, hosting the Muslim Moble Sanctuary, the Jewish Wailin Wall and foundations of Herod's Temple + symbolical place for Christians

WHY?

In Jerusalem, archaeology is politics: why?

Archaeology deals with historical references, which are also part of national and religious identities. It's matter of national roots and legitimacy.

WHY?

Why is Hamas so radical in Gaza Strip?

It's a radical islamic party, which uses popular discontents, lack of democracy & development

WHY?

Why a wall between Israel and the West Bank?

Officially for security reasons – but alos to freeze the Israeli border at the expense of Palestinians

WHY?

Why so many tensions in Old Jerusalem ?

Because of religious intolerance or radicalisations + Israeli-Palestinian conflitcs on a 2-state solution

Who is Israel's best ally ?

The USA, for security concerns + historical ties with the Jewish diaspora in the USA

Iran and the Hezbollah mouvement + Syria
